SET-UP: 7:00-8:30 am

1. Booth spaces are approximately 15' wide X 10' deep.
2. If you need electricity, please provide a 100' extension cord.
3. *If your booth is in excess of 15', you will be assessed a fee of 50% of the original booth space for each additional space! No exceptions!*
4. NO water hook-ups will be available.
5. **Anyone interested in selling food must obtain a Food Service Permit from King County Health Dept. at least 14 days prior to the fair date.**
6. The State of Washington's Drug Paraphernalia law RCW-69.50, states that Drug Paraphernalia cannot be displayed or sold at any booth. This law will be strictly enforced!
7. **NO CRAZY FOAM, SPRAY HAIR DYES, SILLY STRING, STINK BOMBS, GUNS, or KNIVES (including potato and cap guns).**

We reserve the right to ask any vendor to refrain from selling any item we believe is a safety hazard or violates our community standards for decency!
