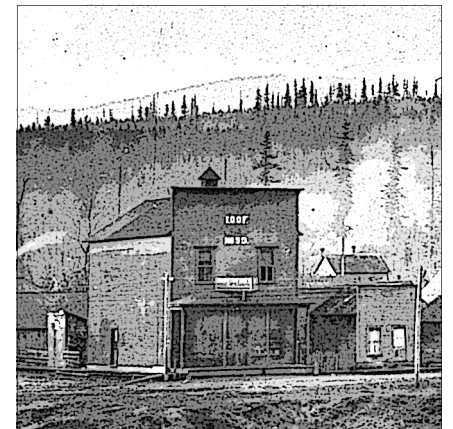

The Society will provide a collection point for books, photographs, documents, artifacts, and other cultural objects which pertain to Fall City history and will strive to make local history visible in the community through signage, publications, and exhibits of various types, with the ultimate goal of a Fall City Museum. The Society will also encourage others to collect, preserve and interpret the history of Fall City.

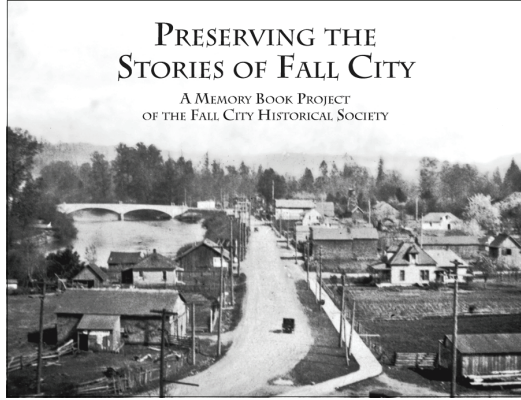

Award-winning Book

In April 2011, the Association of King County Historical Organizations honored our book with the Virginia Marie Folkins Award for "an outstanding historical publication."



The Fall City Memory Book Project, started in November 2007, set out to collect personal stories, firsthand and family memories, and photographs and documents of Fall City throughout the last century. We invited memories from the community, to be recorded in a **Memory Book Workbook** furnished by the Historical Society. Those who completed a Workbook retained the original for their own family history, after a copy was made for addition to the Fall City Permanent Collection and use in assembling a community Memory Book.

Preserving the Stories of Fall City, a 276-page book containing photographs and memories from a total of 54 authors, was published in November 2010.
