Watermelon Eating Contest

OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES

Eligibility: Participants less than 18 years old must have a legal guardian present. There are four general age categories:

- Group 1: Ages 5 to 7 years
- Group 2: Ages 8 to 10 years
- Group 3: Ages 11 to 13 years
- Group 4: Ages 14 or older

To Enter: Read carefully the Official Contest Rules and Entry Form, including the eligibility requirements and waiver of liability provisions. Complete and sign the Entry Form. The forms will be available at the Fall City Days booth on Saturday June 19, 2010 and on the Fall City Web site: www.fallcity.org. Bring the completed Entry Form to Olive Quigley Park by 1:00 PM on the day of the contest to be eligible to participate. A drawing will occur at 1:15 PM to randomly choose the 10 participants that will compete in each age category. The contest begins at 1:30 PM.

Contest Rules: Contestants will compete against each other. The object is to finish a set amount of watermelon, to be determined at time of contest, in the shortest amount of time (5 minutes maximum). Hands free eating is required and all the watermelon must be consumed and not regurgitated or spit up (this will result in ejection from the contest) prior to the completion of the contest. Contestants must not touch any watermelon until the starting signal. Completion of the watermelon eating is to be decided by a judge, not the contestant. Judges will be on hand to assure adherence to the contest rules and to time constraints. The winner will be the person who consumes the entire portion of watermelon in the shortest amount of time. In the event of a tie, the contestants will participate in a second round of eating. The first to finish their portion of watermelon, wins, or so on, until a winner is declared.

Prize Awards: Prize ribbons will be awarded to the first person in each age group who consumes the most watermelon in the allotted time. Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the judges at the completion of the contest. Award winners will be announced on the main parade stage at Fall City Days.

Acknowledgement of Risks and Waiver of Liability: Contestant acknowledges that there are risks of personal injury and illness which may result from participating in the watermelon eating contest. Contestant, as a condition of entry, agrees to indemnify and hold harmless, Farmhouse Market, the Fall City Days Committee and it's representatives from any and all responsibility or damages that may occur to participants as a result of participating in this contest.

Final Authority: The contest will be held rain or shine. Age groupings may change depending upon the number of entries. The judges have the final authority regarding all contest related matters and may cancel the contest at any time.
